Rosemary Richards

Rosemary had been a member of Christ Child since our earliest years in the 1990's. This past June 2024 at the age of 91 she passed away. She left her 3 remaining children and their spouses, 8 grandchildren (and 1 deceased grandchild), and 6 great grandchildren.

Despite losing her husband and a son Rosemary enjoyed life and lived it to the fullest extent possible savoring every experience with her beloved family and friends. One could always find Rosemary smiling as she greeted people whether she had just met them or they were longtime friends. She had a big heart for those in need and was especially drawn to the children we served in Angels' Closet. Finding just the right coat and fitting the child with that new coat was the ministry in Christ Child that she enjoyed the most.

Father Frank Almade

Father Almade, a priest of the Diocese of Pittsburgh, passed away after a lengthy battle with multiple myeloma in August 2024. At the time of his passing he was 70 years of age, and a priest for 46 years. He had a strong interest in Catholic Social Welfare causes, and earned his doctorate focusing on this aspect of Jesus' teachings.

Father was a gregarious man, who loved people, had a great sense of humor and always had a friendly, smiling greeting for those he met. His many skills were important to the Diocesan needs as he was tasked by his Bishops to bring together disparate Parishes into one entity. His latest Parish was recently renamed St. Joseph the Worker, a special cause for Father. An important goal he established for the Parishioners was to make this newly created parish 'The most welcoming Parish in the Diocese of Pittsburgh'. The large number of mourners at his funeral Mass was a testament to how successful he was.

Christ Child members will remember Father as our Spiritual Director in the '90s. One particularly fond memory is of Father modeling a jacket at one of our first Red Wagon Luncheons. He certainly made the fashion show a great success.
