
# Christ Child Society of Pittsburgh Welcomes New Spiritual Director

In October Stacy Doepken delivered 25 Layette bags to Magee Hospital. As always, they were very happy to have our bags. Magee has asked that we only use tightly knitted blankets that are approximately 36 x 36 so the infants can't get their little fingers through the blanket holes. At this time, we will use some other type of receiving blanket for them, possibly a thermal blanket. We are now looking into other options that perhaps can be used.

In November we delivered 10 Layette bags to St. James Parish in Wilkinsburg. That was the first time we delivered to them. They were very grateful and asked for more in the future.

We took snowsuits for the infants to St. James Parish. These were items that Molly had as extras. We are looking into using diapers that are prepackaged in a set of 12 diapers verses packaging diapers ourselves. This will facilitate less handling of diapers and will also be more germ-free. *Charlotte*
